

SW Boatworks Launches a Star



SW BOATWORKS has done it again with *Star*, its new Calvin Beal 38 Special Edition that was named Newport International Boat Show's Best Green Boat in the New Products category for 2018. And *Star's* owners—newly retired with cruising and diving in mind—were “over-the-top happy” with their new boat's quality craftsmanship and set-up.



Star melds classic downeast lines with state-of-the-art green design, top craftsmanship, and superior materials. Like all Calvin Beal designs, this special-edition model is rooted in Maine's rich tradition of seafaring and boatbuilding. As always, SW Boatworks leverages this platform with the latest systems. The 38, with a roomy beam of 15', is a spacious and stable model built from solid fiberglass with a molded foam core top. Powered by a single 500-horsepower Cummins QSC 8.3 diesel engine, *Star* easily cruises at 15 knots and tops out at 19 knots while achieving excellent fuel economy. The Furuno NavNet system provides easy touch control.

Perhaps most exciting is *Star's* solar-charging system,

which eliminates the need for a generator and shore power. Nine cabintop solar panels, each with its own controller, provide power to batteries that start the engine and operate other electrical systems. Then there's *Star's* elegant styling below, featuring a cherry interior in accommodations that include a forward berth, settee, and bench seat.
