Two of our major launches in 2014 were Calvin Beal designs. The 34' pleasure cruiser *Eleanor Cross*, built for a couple in Scituate, Massachusetts, has a solid fiberglass hull with a watertight lazarette and a custom-molded foam-core top. Accommodations include a Sealand vacuum flush head, full V-berth, shower/tread combo, gear locker, full galley up, and Force 10 propane stovetop and oven.

We were also delighted last year to be selected to build the Maine Marine Patrol's next

boat, *Dirigo II*. This 38' Calvin Beal hull, a lobster-fishing design custom-built for law enforcement, incorporates a flush head, two berths, gear locker, and a simple galley below.
